## Assessment

The level one assessment will be run as a training day with one examiner. The day is to be spent covering teaching topics, practicing skills and working on general skiing ability. The assessment tasks are listed in the level one training and exam guide. You will be given numerous attempts at each task creating a relaxed training atmosphere, allowing every opportunity for you to show that you possess the correct skills and understanding to attain the level one certificate.

The APSI exam process has been developed to ensure that each candidate is assessed in a fair and equitable manner. We appreciate feedback and you are encouraged to complete the evaluation forms provided at each course. Completed forms can be returned to your trainer or the APSI office. If you have any concerns regarding your assessment results, please talk to your trainer or technical director.

2018 APSI membership is included in your level one package. APSI membership is valid through until December 31 each year and you will need to renew your membership annually.
