#### Presentation of Financial Report

The treasurer presented the financial report.

#### 2017 Financial Results:

- The association had \$668,000 gross revenue.
  - o Wages accounted for approximately 50% of expenses at \$300,000.
  - \$100,000 was incurred in course and exam costs including trainer meals, travel and accommodation. Plus, there were the usual business expenses.
- The net profit for 2017 is \$111,000.
- The APSI had 1200 members in 2017 and has 916 current members, although more are expected over the year.
- Course and exam participation have increased.

#### 2018 Forecast:

- The cash in bank and net profits are trending upward. However, there is a projected loss in 2018 as pay for Interski 2019. That may change if some expenses are incurred in 2018 and some in 2019.
- Expect return to positive net profit in 2019.

#### Member Benefits:

- Website, manuals, trainer's coordination.
- The Board has an obligation to return profits to members. 25% of net profit has been allocated to fund discipline specific projects.

#### Adoption of accounts


