#### Introduction

The APSI National Team is "one team" of innovative instructors from the five APSI snowsport disciplines, Alpine, Snowboard, Telemark, Nordic and Adaptive. The team will work together over the next four years to: drive the development of snowsport instruction; pedagogy; technique; attend Interski at Levi in 2021; and disseminate the latest innovations to the APSI membership

The APSI is adopting a new team structure with the introduction of a dedicated National Team Coach. The Coach will be responsible for leading, co-ordinating and unifying all five snowsport disciplines, as well as organising team events and fundraising opportunities.

- Creative experimentation on teaching and skiing/riding techniques
- Create and share positive learning experiences with our members
- Grow enthusiasm and excitement for snow sports and our profession
- Present and gather concepts at Interski 2023 on behalf of the APSI and its members
- Working with the members to disseminate information throughout the training term and on return from Interski in 2023
- Attend and assist with organising and running team fundraising events, team social events, team meetings and the annual APSI Spring Festival

## **Coaches Responsibilities**

- Lead the National Team in fulfilling its tasks
- Co-ordinate team training
- Develop innovative fundraising opportunities
- Drive team publicity to attract potential sponsors and supporters

#### Renumeration

The Team Coach is a voluntary position with an expected annual workload of approximately 10 days plus another 2 weeks to attend Interski in 2023. Due to the impact of COVID-19 on the ski industry you may have to self-fund part of your attendance at Interski.

- Is currently involved in the snowsport industry
