### Vertical and Horizontal Clues:

A technique to perform torsional flex – **twist**

Freestyle can be broken into these steps - **ATML**

The most important skill to teach beginners – **stance**

A progression for beginners that are ready to move on snow – **becoming mobile**

A board can have this flex design – **camber**

When you ride in your non-preferred stance direction? **Switch**

Development that refers to how children think and process information - **cognitive**

A method of teaching that helps nervous students – **teacher assist**

Teaching this progression helps students gain edge control across the slope – **skidded traverse**

When you lean, you create this from of edging – **inclination**

An imaginative way to connect words via association with children - **spider webbing**

We use the word 'turn' often to describe this skill - **rotation**

You can do this with students to get them ready for the lesson – **warm up**

A skill that starts with e..... **Edging**

You should check this part of students equipment before the lesson – **boots**

A form of flexion when you move your foot down – **planter**
